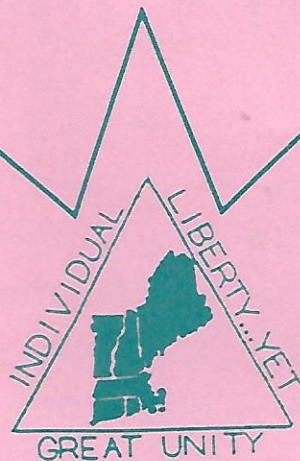

Tradition One

"Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon AA unity." Without unity, AA dies. **Individual liberty, yet great unity.** Key to paradox: each AA's life depends on obedience to spiritual principles. The group must survive or the individual will not. Common welfare comes first. How best to live and work together as groups (Twelve and Twelve, p. 9).

Our relationships with the general public should be characterized by personal anonymity. We think AA ought to avoid sensational advertising. Our names and pictures as AA members ought not be broadcast, filmed, or publicly printed. Our public relations should be guided by the principle of attraction rather than promotion. There is never need to praise ourselves. We feel it better to let our friends recommend us (Twelve and Twelve, p. 192).

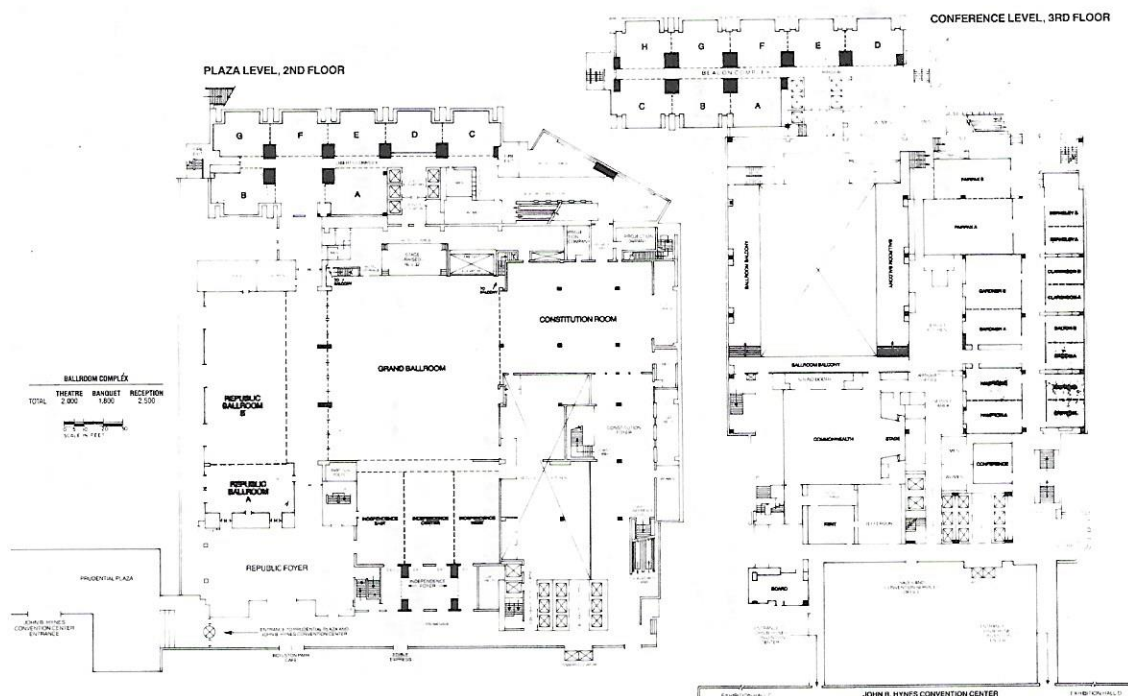

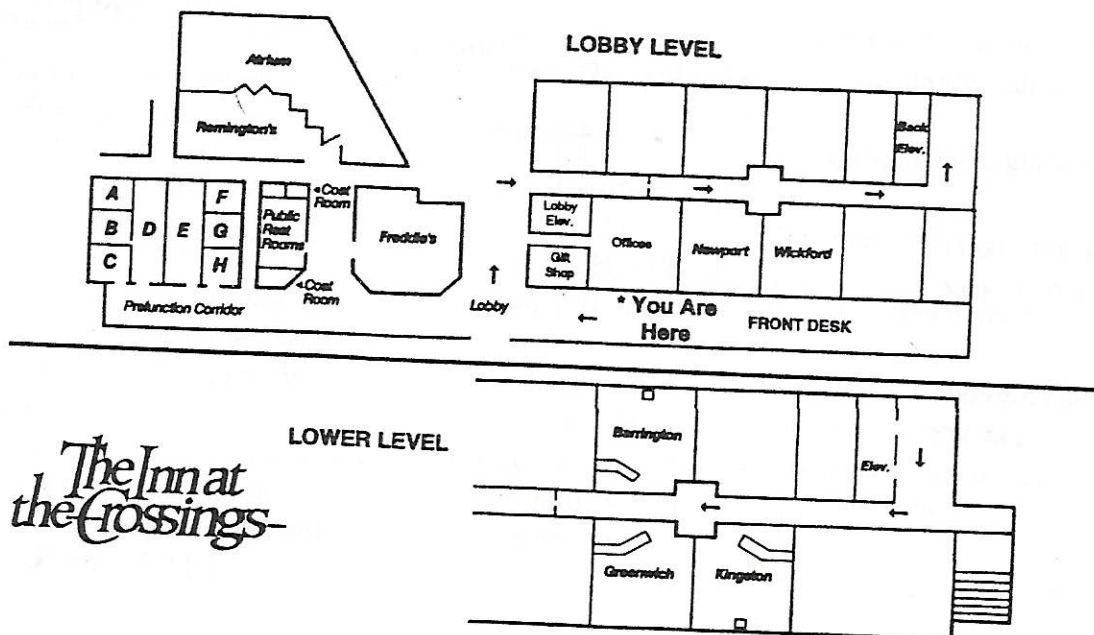
WELCOME FRIENDS

Nothing, absolutely nothing, happens in God's world by mistake. Until I could accept my alcoholism, I could not stay sober; unless I accept life completely on life's terms, I cannot be happy. I need to concentrate not so much on what needs to be changed in the world as on what needs to be changed in me and my attitudes."
